Dear Parents,

What **exciting times at St. John's** of late with Science Week, Book Week and all the blended learning occurring in classrooms. This places an importance on integrating technology into learning to spark and maintain student engagement.

Parent Teacher meetings commence next week. I encourage all parents to make a Parent Teacher Meeting appointment to discuss your child's progress with class teachers. I say again, how important these meetings are.

Presently, we are experiencing an influx in expressions of interest in enrolments for 2022. Next **Tuesday**, **7th September we will host our Kindy and School Open Morning from 9:00am - 11:00am.** I invite all parents who may be interested in seeing what makes our school great to attend, especially parents who have Prep children commencing in 2022.

In 2022, **St. John's School will operate with 4 classes** which allows for small class sizes. At this stage the configuration will be;

- ⇒ Year 5/6 class

This week we are **celebrating Fathers' Day** with a **thanksgiving liturgy** for our dads and all those who perform father figure roles. This will be followed by **fun activities** which the students will do with their dads. 

Delivering quality and affordable learning outcomes for students from Kindy to Year 6



What a busy two weeks we have had with What a **busy two weeks** we have had with different themed National Weeks leading our Kindergarten programming. Science Week

this year had the theme of 'Food: Different by Design'. For our Kindergarten group this was very suited to our gardening interests and projects. At Kindy we began an experiment to see if we can grow new things from our food scraps. We used different vegetable items - carrot tops and basil cuttings from our garden, an avocado seed and the base of a celery - and set these up in water to see what might happen. The children have been checking on their progress every day and have observed the celery begin to re-grow very quickly, the carrot tops followed soon after - although we decided we wouldn't actually get a new carrot from this! We are watching and waiting to see what the avocado and basil might do!



During Science week we also used our ample harvest of yellow cherry tomatoes to make a pasta sauce, and ate it with pasta we made from scratch. Yum! We finished off the week with a fantastic Science session with Mrs Bryan at St John's. Thank you for giving us your time. Everyone had a ball and we all learnt so much about bees and pollination!

Book Week was another fun week filled sharing favourite story books from home and engaging in play provocations on various books. A favourite was definitely 'The Gruffalo', and visiting St John's on Friday. We finished our visit off with a play at the Prep/1 classroom. Thank you to Mrs Parisi, as well as Mrs Gaia and your students for your hospitality and entertainment.
