Welcome to term 2. It was a sombre start to the term having received the news on Easter Monday that Pope Francis had passed away. Bishop Joseph described Pope Francis as "a champion of the poor" who promoted "care for all creation". We pray for his eternal rest.

It was a privilege to commemorate **Anzac Day** with students, staff, parents and community members last week. Many gathered for the march and service at Kurrimine Beach. Our Year 6 students led the service paying tribute to the brave men and women who have served and sacrificed for our country.
